
## Liberia means "Land of the Free" in Latin. The region was settled by freed slaves from America during the pre-Civil War era.

## HELLO, I AM BORSAH DINGWALL


I live in Liberia where palm trees wave their branches in the tropical heat and people always have time to stop and talk.



Provides much-needed medicines to people who suffer from illness and ailments in parts of the world where access to medical supplies and medicine is limited.




Save-A-Life

Supplies funds to provide wells, cisterns, water filters, and irrigation systems.




